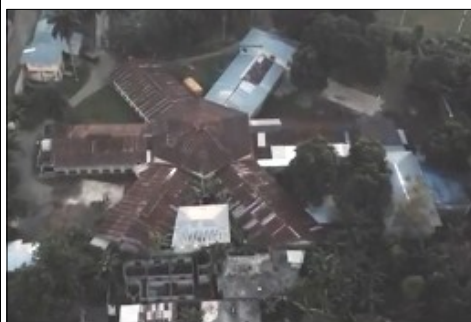
Solar Yard Light Project Update

Our thanks to those who gave for the solar light project. We are within \$1,500 of the \$4000 we need to complete this project. We would like to send this money in May and get these lights up and running.

New Roof Needed

The oldest roof on the compound was built in 2001. That is already 17 years old. At that time we used metal roofing bought in Haiti which was the only thing available and the quality was not great. Now its time to secure our investment and replace most of this tin on this large building that is home to all activities for the Haitians.

A contractor on the last team counted the number of sheets needed and came up with 861, plus ridge cap and screws. He also offered to use his construction discount and worked with a Christian business to come up with a great deal at present prices. All metal is due to go up 30% in the next few months. The board has given approval to purchase this now using reserve funds. **The total for all of this is \$21,321.** We would like to return as much money as possible to our reserve funds. This is not an ordinary request but something that is necessary to maintain what God has blessed us with.
